- Media and Creative Industries
- Public Health
- Skill Trades and Construction Technology

Eligibility:

- Black-identifying TDSB student (current, graduating or returning)
- Must be available for pre-employment training once a week for 1.5 hrs (April 7-May 26)
- Must be 16 as of July 1, 2022
- Must be available to commit to the program full-time (July 4-Aug 19)
