Black Student Summer Leadership Program (BSSLP) The BSSLP is a 7-week (July 4 - August 19) <u>paid</u> Leadership Program that provides Black students with the opportunity to work with organizations that can provide you with experiential learning in various career fields. Eligibility: Black-identifying TDSB student (current, graduating or returning); must be available for pre-employment training once a week for 1.5 hrs (April 7-May 26); must be 16 as of July 1, 2022, and must be available to commit to the program full-time (July 4-Aug 19).
