## **YEARBOOK DISTRIBUTION**

### **EXAM SCHEDULE AND INFORMATION**

Information about our exams and exam schedule has been sent out previously. Our exam schedule begins on Tuesday, June 20, 2023 and we have 2 exam blocks per day: 9am or 1pm. Students will be writing exams during those times unless given special instructions (ie. students with accommodations in our Special Education Program). If a student does not have an exam on that day, they do NOT need to come to school unless they need to access Credit Rescue opportunities. #### **CREDIT RESCUE WEEK**

Credit Rescue Week is happening during all the days of the exam period (see attached PDF schedule on email), June 20 - 23, from 9:00am - 11:00am and 1:00pm - 3:00pm in Room 228. Teachers will notify students who need to attend Credit Rescue week in order to prepare for, or complete, a test or assignment that is required for them to earn a credit. Students are welcome to come to Room 228 at any time during Credit Rescue Week, but if they come on the days dedicated to specific departments, teachers will be present with special expertise in those areas. Teachers will also be handing students a paper invitation to attend Credit Rescue Week. This is an important opportunity for students who are close to earning a particular credit, but need to demonstrate some important learning before attaining that credit!
