Here are some important items and reminders:

Student Immunization Campaign

Starting in March, students in Grades 7-12 will be able to receive the meningococcal, human papillomavirus and hepatitis B vaccines, if they have not already received them in Toronto Public Health vaccination clinics. Please see the PDFs (Parent Package, Consent Form and Fact Sheet) attached to the email.

Extracurricular sports and teams

As we move on to the next set of extracurricular sports teams, we are awaiting further clarification from the TDSB and Toronto Public Health regarding participation requirements. At the moment, we follow our Operational Guidelines which states:

The TDSB has made a decision to require all students aged 12+ to be fully vaccinated to participate in winter sports (e.g. basketball, ice hockey, swimming, etc.). This decision is consistent with recommendations from Toronto Public Health and has been made with the health and safety of students and staff in mind. Specifically, this vaccination requirement applies to sports/teams that involve competition between schools, mixing of students and travel to other TDSB schools and/or external venues.

General:

- All students will be required to be fully vaccinated by January 3, 2022 or prior to league play
- Teams with student athletes that are fully vaccinated can now participate in practices and scheduled games
- Vaccination status will be collected through the Service Now App
- Students requiring accommodations must see their administration

I'm sure there will be more information to come in the near future. Thank you for your patience.
