

Hello Harbord parents/guardians and students:

As you are likely aware, **all schools in Toronto, including those at the TDSB, will be closed to in-person learning as of Wednesday, April 7, 2021 and remain closed up to and including Sunday, April 18, 2021.** This TPH order is being made under Section 22 of Ontario's Health Protection and Promotion Act in an effort to slow the spread of COVID-19. This means that schools are closed to in-person learning for the remainder of this week. All teachers will be teaching their classes remotely from home. At Harbord, we will continue to follow our existing schedule to provide consistency for our students and staff. **Student and staff wellbeing are paramount during this time.** Tomorrow is a Day 3, so students who would've come into the building for your face-to-face learning will engage in live online learning at 8:45am (teachers will communicate with students and provide them the code/link). For our students who would have engaged in asynchronous learning, they will continue to have the asynchronous learning period (and follow the plans/instructions that are originally scheduled). We will finish this week with that direction. The 2pm classes will continue as usual. Remember, Thursday is a Day 4 and Friday is a Day 1. Attendance will be taken as we normally would (and through the same platforms during asynchronous learning). **Again, all students should check their online platforms (Google Classroom/Brightspace or via email) for specific information about their class instructions for the remainder of the week.**
