

## Hello parents/guardians and students:

We are soooo excited to be welcoming your child to Harbord this year! First day of in-person school is either Thursday or Friday depending on whether you have a first period in-person class. Regardless of that, all students have a 2pm live online classes every day. Students and families should have received their child's timetables via email by now. A secure password must be entered to retrieve the timetable. The password is the birthdate of your child. The format must be MM/DD/YYYY including the forward slashes (example – 05/03/2004 for birthdate May 3, 2004). Thursday September 17 is a Day 1 and Friday September 18 is a Day 2.

The following example is of a student who will be coming in-person on Thursday (Day 1). The student will be permitted to enter the building at 8:30am through the Northeast or Southwest doors (class is 308  $-3^{rd}$  floor) after being greeted by staff. Staff will verify that the required Health self-assessment for COVID-19 symptoms is completed. Again, doors open at 8:30am. This student will leave the building at the end of period 1 class and return home. The student will sign-in to an online class at 2pm.



The following example is of a student who will be coming in-person on Friday (Day 2). This student does have a live online class on Thursday at 2pm and will sign in at that time. On Friday, this student will be permitted to enter the building at 8:30am through the Northwest doors (class is  $204 - 2^{nd}$  floor) after being greeted by staff. Staff will verify that the required Health self-assessment for COVID-19 symptoms is completed. Again, doors open at 8:30am. This student will leave the building at the end of period 1 class and return home. The student will sign-in to an online class at 2pm.



As mentioned in previous communications, please have your child use the **Health Screening NOW** 

**mobile App!!!** It is the easiest way for your child to enter the building --- and FASTEST too! Think of this as the Nexus line at the border or the VIP line with quick access. More information can be found at <u>verification of a self-assessment</u>. If a student does not have a verification to show a self-assessment was completed, as a high school student, they will be given a copy of the <u>TDSB Student Health Pass</u> and asked to complete it prior to entry. Again... have your child use the Health Screening <u>NOW mobile App!!! NOW mobile App!!! NOW mobile App!!!</u>

We highly recommend that students arrive at 8:30am to start the screening verification as classes start at 8:45am. Remember, there are four entrances and students will enter based on where their class is located:

- Northeast and Southwest entrance classes on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor
- Northwest entrance classes on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor
- Southeast entrance classes in the basement or on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor
