### OPENING DAY PROCEDURES FOR SEPTEMBER 5, 2023 SCHEDULE FOR ALL GRADES 9-12

**To all 2023 – 2024 Harbord students --- We are all super excited to see you!!!**

Student timetables will be made available on the TDSB Connects App on Friday, September 1, 2023. Please visit your 'App Store' to download The TDSB Connects App or update the app if needed. Please check the TDSB Connects App on that day at 3 p.m. Please note that for some students, changes to that timetable may still occur.

**The first day of school is Tuesday, September 5, 2023.** Students will arrive at the designated time and go to their semester 1 period 1 class. During period 1 class, students will:

- Meet period 1 teacher and receive information about the school, our Student Handbook, school expectations, timetable, and locker -  
**Students owing textbooks, library books or other materials will be referred to the office.**
- Go to the gym with their period 1 teacher to have their school photo taken and to receive a SAC card.

We are proud at Harbord that all of the money collected from our student activity fee is given to the student council to be distributed to students from students. Please note the fee is \$60. Please call the school and speak to a Vice-Principal if you know of anyone who may need assistance with this fee. This fee covers:

- \$30 for the yearbook
- \$25-\$30 distributed among many clubs and organizations in the school to enrich student experiences by providing intramurals, varsity athletic teams, debating, helping to pay for guest speakers and performers, environmental initiatives, theatre events, and much more. Please refer to the list of clubs and teams for a more extensive list. This amount also helps offset the cost of the semi-formal, dances, welcome back and farewell BBQs, talent show and prom.
- Provides a Student Activity Card (SAC) used for student identification on the TTC.

**Regarding timetables:**

- ◆ 2023 – 2024 timetables will not be made available prior to September 1, 2023 (access timetables via TDSB Connects App)
- ◆ Timetable changes will reflect courses taken at summer school. However, you may have a timetable problem if:
  1. You did not pass your summer school course.
  2. You signed up for summer school however, did not attend.
  3. You attended summer school in another school board.

**If any of the above applies to you, please contact the Guidance Office and your Guidance Counsellor to correct your timetable before school starts.**
