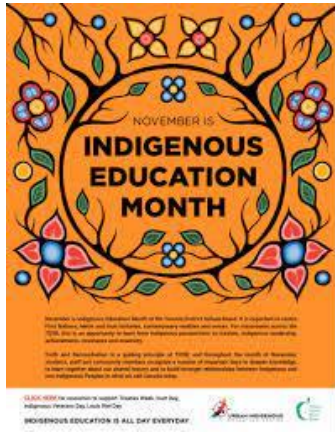
Hope everyone continues to be well and have enjoyed the beautiful autumn weather this week. Sending out a really short communication with only a few items:
