Our Curriculum Night and welcome barbecue is scheduled for Thursday September 27th. This will be an opportunity meet our staff, other parents and to learn about the curriculum your children will be studying and investigating. We have had a few staff changes and a lot of enrollment over the summer, but we have done our best to maintain consistency as much as possible. Unfortunately Ms Thawer will not be able to join us this year as planned. Some of you already know Ms Samuels who was in for Ms Donelan last year. She will be commencing the year for her grade three class until the posting process is finished. Likewise Ms Wolfe will be in to start the year off for Ms Priya's class. We really appreciate her coming in to set up the room as well. As well, Ms Shin had to take her maternity leave earlier than planned and we are happy to welcome back Ms Yap who are filling in for us during the posting process for her kindergarten class. We would like to also welcome Ms Anagnostopoulos who will be joining our ESL team. Finally Matina Stamadianos will be joining us in the office as our morning secretary alongside Laurie Johnston.

Opening Day Sept 4th

In September students will be meeting their teachers outside at 8:25am. The teachers will have attendance lists and there will be yellow signs to indicate which grades are located where. Kindergarten will be in the kindergarten playground area. Grades 1-3 teachers will be along the parking lot fence outside the west doors. Grades 4-6 will meet staff outside Portables 1 and 2. In the event of rain kindergarten will meet in the gym, grades 1-3 in the library area and 4-6 between the East and West doors.

Student and School Safety

Supervision in the building and yard begins at 8:25a.m. After school yard supervision ends at 3:25. For safety, students should not be left on school property without an adult before 8:25a.m. or after 3:25 p.m.

One measure of keeping your children safe is to ensure we can account for any absences or reasons for them being late to school. We would like to remind you that if your child is going to be absent or late for any reason, please phone the office immediately at 416-395-2567, select option 1 and report the reason for the absence or lateness.

With this in mind, it is important that you keep current contact information on file at the office. Please let the office know immediately if your contact information changes at any time throughout the school year.

We recognize that regular attendance is essential to the safety, academic success, and well-being of all students. Thank you for your continued cooperation to keep your children safe and accounted for.

Parking and Drop-offs

Hollywood's location on the street, position of its parking lot and playgrounds make it a challenging place for pick up and drop off. As well the small size of the parking lot combined with a school operating beyond capacity with 9 portables creates some additional challenges. **The School Parking Lot is for staff ONLY** as there are no extra spaces. It is not available for drop off as there are currently only enough spots for staff and the staff need to be able to get into their spots un- encumbered so they can supervise their students. Students should NOT be walking through the parking lot at any time and should enter the playground areas through the sidewalk entrances on Hollywood or Estelle.

Safe areas for drop off and parking are listed below:

Drop off without leaving your vehicle: the front bus loop (off of Hollywood Ave.) Due to fire safety regulations temporary and/or permanent parking is NOT permitted.

Parking -15 minute parking on Hollywood Ave., Highgate Ave., or Estelle Ave. Please be aware that there is a bus zone on Estelle Ave. Please follow the signs carefully to keep our students safe.

Please plan your morning accordingly so that your child(ren) arrive safely at school and in time to start his/her day. A school bell will ring at 8:35am daily.

Secure Access System

A reminder to parents that we have a secure access system installed at our main entry that gives our school staff more control over who enters our school. This means that when you arrive at our school the outside doors will be locked and a buzzer system will need to be used to gain access to the school. Using this system will provide a safe and welcoming environment and a single point of entry where visitors will be welcomed and directed to the main office.

Update on Attendance/Enrollment

As we continue to receive new registration and verify students leaving our school it is possible that some reorganization of classes will take place in mid-September. Class changes will **only** occur based on class sizes. This is caused when a new classroom needs to be created due to high numbers or an existing classrooms needs to be collapsed due to low numbers. If changes occur, families will be further informed prior to class reassignment. Currently all our primary classes are at the required size and our junior classes are well balanced but sitting at 30-32 students which is similar to our past sizes in those grades.
