## 3. Parent/Teacher Recommendations for Fundraising Allocation (leftover school yard funds)

- Mr. Maldonato:
  - \$727.00 for 22 new jerseys to fit junior and snr students (uniforms 26+ years old) approved
  - ~\$500: 3 sets of spikeball; works on team co-operation, hand-eye cooperation approved
- Mrs. Maldonato (music has \$5000/year budget that usually only covers repairs):
  - o \$1200: replace two trombones *approved*
  - o \$1500: tenor saxophone *approved*
  - \$2500: bows need to be re-haired & replaced (148 instruments & 50+ needing to be replaced) approved
- Grade 8 Students
  - o robotics program for grades 6, 7, 8 (increase sophistication of robots) approved
  - \$1300: \$430 1 minestore; \$450: 3 sphero; \$420: 6 ozzo bots approved
  - o \$1921 (200 t-shirts for cross country and Track & Field) *approved*
- \$2300 = support investment in technology for junior division (to be added to \$4000 from current school operating budget) *approved* 
  - o Goal = 14 chromebooks (\$300 ea) + 7 tech tubs (\$300 ea); currently 6 chromebooks/class room
- Purchase a sign to commemorate and explain the meaning of the "historical themed park; sandbox and playground area in front of the school)
  - \$300 indoor plaque hold
  - \$1300 exterior bronze-type plaque hold
- \$2200: Bronze plaque TDSB approval; administration support; should be outside; Heritage Toronto Plaque registered with society (write and do annual cleaning) commemorate only *hold*
- \$2603: Prolog, People of the Pacific; 4 performances (1<sup>st</sup> day after March Break) approved
- \$1500: 3 ipads to deliver differentiated learning; Technology to help with differentiated learning (7 grade ones, 6 grade 2s) *approved (1 approved for \$500)*
- \$127.07: French literacy resources for grade 4 french immersion; magazines (82.43); monthly fiction stories and audio for ipad (\$44.64) *approved*
- \$329.20: adjustable training hurdles for grades 6 to 8 *approved*
- \$650: Tiny Town Vaughn; integrating French & English streams field trip approved

- Short and long term goals to drive integration and ensure positive profile for English stream, teachers, students, families

- Long term: get a sense of the barriers from teachers, parents, administration, etc

# 9. Caring & Safe Schools Update

- Participated in Causal Model Exercise (to make thinking visible and make connections). Dissecting the question of what causes a school to be inclusive and equitable? Find big areas and keep asking, what causes that, what causes that, what causes that?
- Goal: create environment where everyone gets along well
- Next steps: get parent feedback how do you know that your child is being understood at school?
  - Work in progress three other areas to flush out: 1) diversity of learning experience 2) create welcoming environment and celebrate diversity and parent engagement; 3) measuring and monitoring impact
- Miss Drynan has taken health/mental well-being into her portfolio grade 7/8 (facilitating discussions on sexual health, bullying, online bullying, etc)
- Need safe space for parent engagement and ability to challenge the status quo
- Next steps: needs to be a follow-on discussion re bullying; building out teacher strategies
