Reporting and Responding to Racism and Hate Incidents



In October, we highlighted this policy for families and visited every classroom from Grade 4-8.

We discussed the TDSB <u>Human Rights Policy</u> and the Ontario Human Rights Code with respect to prohibiting harassment and discrimination on the basis on the following protected grounds:

• Age • Ancestry • Citizenship • Colour • Creed (faith) • Disability • Ethnic origin • Family status • Gender • Gender identity • Marital status • Place of origin • Race • Same-sex partnership status • Sexual orientation

Socio-economic status

We stressed the seriousness of using language that is racist, hateful or discriminates and the resulting consequences. When these incidents happen, we also reach out to our Caring and Safe Schools Advisor for consultation and perspective.

Despite our proactive approach, these incidents continue to rise. Students are using discriminatory language that is hurtful and is causing harm to those students witnessing these incidents.

Often, students are not reporting these incidents when they happen and it becomes very difficult to further investigate. We continue to remind students to report any of these incidents right away to a staff member. We encourage you to have a discussion with your child about this topic also.


