## **Lockdown Drill and Fire Drills**

All TDSB schools are expected to hold 2 lockdown drills each school year. At Humbercrest, we will hold our first lockdown drill next week. All students will be given advanced notice about this drill during morning announcements.

Our first Fire Drill will also take place next week - we will be holding 3 Fire Drills in total this Fall.

Practicing these drills gives us an opportunity to see if there are any changes that need to be made to our Emergency Procedures.

## Road Safety - Scooters, Bikes and Skateboards

It is great to see so many of our students using different modes of transportation to get to and from school. If your child is riding any of these items to school, by law they should be wearing an approved bicycle helmet. All scooters, bikes and skateboards must be either locked on a bike rack or stored in a student's locker. Unfortunately we do not have space in our classrooms or in the office to store electric scooters for safety purposes. At no time should electric scooters be driven on school grounds due to the speed at which they maintain. We appreciate your understanding with this matter.
