

# Humberside Collegiate Institute

## **REGISTRATION INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS – 2021/2022**

In accordance with TDSB Operational Procedure PR 518 Admission Eligibility Requirements revised January 28, 2020, parents wishing to register their child/children in Humberside C.I. must prove their residency within school boundaries as defined by TDSB regulations.

Humberside is closed to Optional Attendance. Students and parents must live within school boundaries to attend Humberside in the English program. Admission to the Extended French and French Immersion programs is open to those students coming through the designated TDSB French 'pathway' feeder schools: Fern, Humbercrest, Rockcliffe, Runnymede, Swansea.

Parent(s)/Guardian(s) are required to show **three documents** to prove residency and address.

The following is required in the parent/guardian name:

- Signed formal lease or rental agreement OR Deed of property, current property tax invoice or original interim property tax invoice
- Recent correspondence from a government agency (example: Revenue Canada Income Tax Assessment, Municipal, Federal or Provincial Government Agency)

Proof of Address may also be any of the following which **must display the name of the parent/guardian**. If the name and address are not displayed, the original envelope with that information must also be produced. (These documents will not be accepted if in the name of a business.)

**ONE** of the following are required:

- Current Utility Invoice (Toronto Hydro, Enbridge Gas or Oil, City of Toronto Water)
- Residential Telephone/Internet/Cable Invoice
- Current Motor Vehicle Ownership Registration and Insurance
- Current Bank Statement
- Credit Card Statement

Personal information regarding finances may be blocked out on the statements, forms and invoices.

### **Driver's Licence will not be accepted**

Grade 9 registration appointments will be made for grade 8 students who are not presently students within the TDSB and for all other students transferring to Humberside in grades 10 to 12.

The following additional documentation is required for this appointment:

- Birth Certificate or Passport or Work/Study Permit or Proof of Canadian Residency/Citizenship

### **Additional Documents Required:**

- Health Card
- IEP – Individual Education Plan; IPRC documentation
- **Grade 8 students:** most recent report card
- **Grade 9 – 12 students:** Credit Counselling Summary
- **Principal's Report**

***Families must reside at the in-district residential address at the time of registration***
