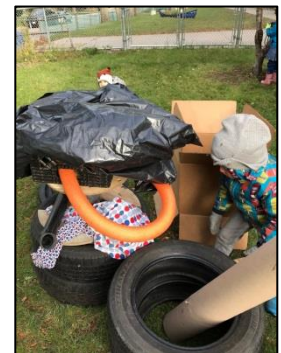


### Call-out for LOOSE PARTS!
