- 2. May's Character Trait of the Month is Integrity: Integrity is the act of following ones moral and ethical convictions and doing the right thing in all circumstances regardless of whether some is watching or not. Some simple ways to build integrity for students at home:
 - **Establish Positive Habits**: Much of integrity is the building of positive habits. Constantly doing positive actions leads to positive outcomes in life.
 - **Boost Empathy**: By promoting empathy children are more likely to halt behaviours that are hurtful to others.
 - Know What you Stand For: As parents have a list of virtues and beliefs that act as our moral code and by having this, we are able to model, guide and teach our children
 - Walk the Talk: If our children see us (parents) living a life of integrity they are more likely to strive towards living this way
 - Let Your Word Stand: Follow through is the baseline for integrity. Whether it is reading a story later or following through on a consequence---follow through is integrity in action
- 3. **Bike Safety**: With warmer whether on it's way children will be outside participating in activities such as bike riding. A couple of tips to ensure the safety of our kids:
 - Make sure all children/youth under the age of 18 wear a helmet as the Ontario law requires this
 - Ensure children are riding in a safe space
 - Teach children how to steer, break and ride in a straight line
 - Do a safety check everytime they ride a bike, scooter or skateboard to ensure they are in good working order
 - Always walk a bike across an intersection
 - Be a good role model wear a helmet and safety gear yourself. Children copy what adults do.
