- e. Kindness Ninjas are part of a growing group globally that are spreading good deeds to others. The idea of the Kindness Ninja is really simple. When it is your turn, do a secret act of kindness for someone in your family and leave a picture of the Kindness Ninja (create your own) where you did the act of kindness, ready for someone to find!
- **3.** *Powerful Words:* Consider the sweet potential behind that tiny disclaimer "yet." There's something stunningly honest and uplifting about telling a child that a goal hasn't been mastered . . . yet. Keep at it. You're almost there -- not yet -- but soon

4. Weekly Reflection Journals: Every Friday, students could cap a week of learning with a self-rating journal entry like "Something New I Learned" or "This Week's Memorable Moment." To test their perseverance, you could add a new prompt: "Something I Struggled With." In this small space, there is both a mirror and a window. Students look into the mirror and admit an area of growth. Parents look through a window and perceive an opportunity. I'm still amazed by how honestly students answer this prompt.
