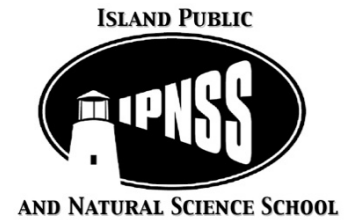

IPS TRANSPORTATION AND DROP-OFF & PICK-UP ROUTINES FROM APRIL 11TH UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

The Spring Ferry Schedule begins for our school day commute on Tuesday, April 11th until further notice. Please review these routines and be on time for drop off in the morning and pick up/receiving your child(ren) in the afternoon.

City-Side Families at the Jack Layton Ferry Terminal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Kindergarten to Grade 6 City-side Students will take the 8:30 am ferry to Centre Island There will only be one drop off time (all Kindergarten students will travel together – there will be no sibling boarding during the new schedule) Students will be Supervised by Travel Safety Assistants Students will be transported from Centre Island by school bus to the school. Occasionally, students will also be able to walk with their classroom teachers from the ferry docks to school in the morning – weather permitting. Gibraltar Point Nursery students will take the 8:30 am ferry to Centre Island to catch the school bus
