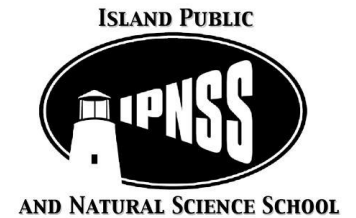

City-Side Boarding the Ferry

- **Grade 1 to 6** Students may board the ferry to be seated in their designated areas
- **Kindergarten Students** may enter the pre-paid area to check-in with the Travel Safety Assistants; once checked-in they may proceed to board the ferry to be seated in their designated areas

DROP-OFF	September 21 st (no changes in morning routines)
<u>City-Side Families @ the Jack Layton Ferry Docks</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Kindergarten to Grade 6 City-side students will take the 8:30am ferry to Centre Island ● Students will be supervised by Travel Safety Assistants ● Students will be transported from Centre Island by school bus to the school ● Gibraltar Point Nursery students will take the 8:30 am ferry to Centre Island to catch the school bus
<u>Island-side Families @ Ward's Docks</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Kindergarten to Grade 6 students can take the 8:45am school bus from Ward's Island ● Students will be transported from Ward's Island by school bus to the school

PICK-UP	September 21 st
<u>City-Side Families @ Jack Layton Ferry Docks</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Kindergarten to Grade 6 City-side students & Gibraltar Point Nursery will take the 3:40 pm (3:45 pm) Hanlan's Point Ferry arriving in the city at 4:00 pm; supervised by Travel Safety Assistants <p><u>When City-Side Students arrive:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Kindergarten Students will be located within the ferry compound with their designated Travel Safety Assistant ● Grade 1 & 2 Students will be located just inside the ticket booth area ● Grade 3 to 6 Students will be located <i>outside</i> the ticket booth near the Westin Hotel ● Please check-in with your Travel Safety Assistant prior to picking up your child
<u>Island-side Families @ Ward's Docks</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students will arrive at Ward's Island at 3:45pm for pick up ● Please check-in with your bus driver prior to picking up your child

IPS Family Access Card Continues

Through the agreement of the Toronto Ferry Port Authority, IPS Parents/Guardians will continue to be able to access the Jack Layton Ferry Docks inner compound prepaid area temporarily to safely drop-off and pick-up their child(ren). For IPS Parents/Guardians to continue to access the ferry compound with their child, they must show the **IPS Parent/Guardian Access Card 2022-23** to ferry dock staff.
