<u>City-Side Families @ the Ferry Docks</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Kindergarten to Grade 6 City-side Students will take the 8:30 am ferry to Hanlan's Point. There will only be one drop off time (all Kindergarten students will travel together – there will be no sibling boarding during the new schedule) Students will be supervised by Travel Safety Assistants Gr. 1 to Gr. 6 and Kindergarten students will be transported from Hanlan's Point by school bus to the school. Gibraltar Point Nursery students will take the 8:30 am ferry to Hanlan's Point to catch the school bus
<u>Island-side Families @ Ward's Docks</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Kindergarten to Grade 6 Island-side Students may take the 8:30 am school bus from Wards Island to meet city-side students at Hanlan's Point at 8:45 am, and continue to school
