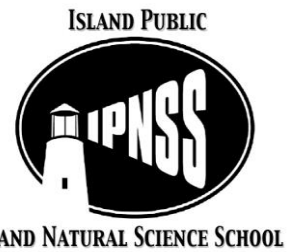

Dear Island Public School Families,

Thank you to all IPS Families for their continued support and patience as we continue to ensure the safe transportation of IPS Students & Staff. As of January 3, 2022, the Ongiara has been the only ferry used during the winter schedule which has a limited capacity of 220 passengers. This presents a challenge to IPS as the ferry cannot accommodate all students & staff in one trip. As you know the ferry is also shared by several other community groups including Gibraltar Day Nursery and Waterfront Montessori Children's Centre. In light of this, we will be required to have grade specific pick-up/drop-off and entry/exit times. **Please review the updated routines beginning Monday, January 17, 2022.**
