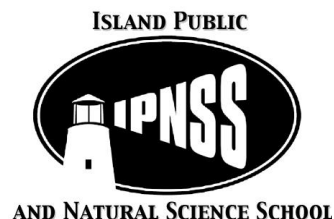

## 2019 Spring Ferry Schedule & Student Departure and Arrival Information

### Spring Information: Beginning April 12<sup>th</sup>

#### City-side Students: Grade 1 to 6

- Please meet the Travel Safety Assistants at 8:15am to board the 8:30am ferry to Ward's Island
- Travel Safety Assistants will be at the ferry docks beginning at 8:15am to greet students
- At the end of the day, Grade 1 to 6 students will take the 4:15pm ferry from Hanlan's Point to the city-side ferry docks and arrive by 4:30pm. Parents are to arrive at the city-side ferry docks no later than 4:45pm to meet students

#### City-side Kindergarten Students

- Please meet the Travel Safety Assistants by 8:50am to board the 9:00am ferry to Centre Island
- Travel Safety Assistants will be at the ferry docks beginning at 8:30am to greet students
- At the end of the day, kindergarten students will take the 3:45pm ferry from Hanlan's Point to the city-side ferry docks and arrive by 4:00pm. Parents are to arrive at the city side ferry docks to meet students no later than 4:30pm.

#### All Island-side Students (Kindergarten to Grade 6)

- Students are welcome to begin to board the school bus by 8:45am at Ward's Island Ferry Docks
- The school bus will leave once the Grade 1 to 6 City-side students arrive at Ward's Island Ferry Docks
- At the end of the day, Island-side parents are to meet students at Ward's Island ferry dock by 3:55pm

## FERRY DOCK DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP STUDENT ROUTINE

As you know ALL Island Public School Parents/Guardians must show the IPS Parent Access Card in order to be given permission to temporarily enter the ferry docks compound for drop-off and/or pick-up of students.

Families were provided with two access cards.
