

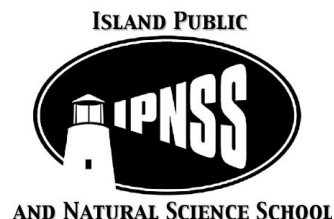

2019 Summer Ferry Schedule & Student Drop-off & Pick-up Information

Summer Information: Beginning May 15th

City-side Students: Grade 1 to 6

- Please meet the Travel Safety Assistants by 8:30am to board the 8:45am ferry to Ward's Island
- Travel Safety Assistants will be at the ferry docks beginning at 8:15am to greet students
- At the end of the day, Grade 1 to 6 students will take the 4:15pm ferry from Hanlan's Point to the city-side ferry docks and arrive by 4:30pm. Parents are to arrive at the city-side ferry docks no later than 4:45pm to meet students

City-side Kindergarten Students

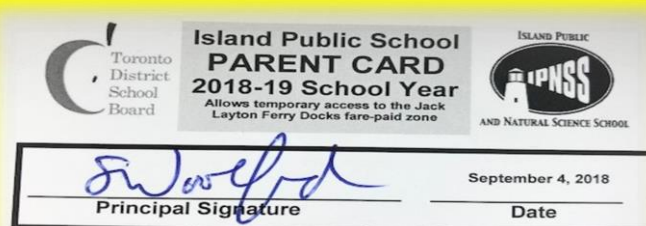
- Please meet the Travel Safety Assistants by 8:50am to board the 9:00am ferry to Hanlan's Point
- Travel Safety Assistants will be at the ferry docks beginning at 8:30am to greet students
- At the end of the day, kindergarten students will take the 3:45pm ferry from Hanlan's Point to the city-side ferry docks and arrive by 4:00pm. Parents are to arrive at the city side ferry docks to meet students no later than 4:30pm.

All Island-side Students (Kindergarten to Grade 6)

- Students are welcome to begin to board the school bus by 8:45am at Ward's Island Ferry Docks
- The school bus will leave once the Grade 1 to 6 City-side students arrive at Ward's Island Ferry Docks
- At the end of the day, Island-side parents are to meet students at Ward's Island ferry dock by 3:55pm

FERRY DOCK DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP STUDENT ROUTINE

As you know ALL Island Public School Parents/Guardians must show the IPS Parent Access Card in order to be given permission to temporarily enter the ferry docks compound for drop-off and/or pick-up of students. Families were provided with two access cards. In addition, you may also take a picture of the card and upload it to your cell phone to show when requested. Thank you for continued support.



City-Side Drop-off/Pick-up Reminder

Student safety is our number one concern. Families who use the temporary drop-off/pick-up parking located in the Harbour Square Visitor Parking area, are reminded travel safely through the parking lot with your child(ren) in-hand. In addition, we encourage families who walk to the ferry docks from Harbour Square to use the pedestrian boardwalk as the safest way to travel to and from school and to avoid using the visitor parking lot.
