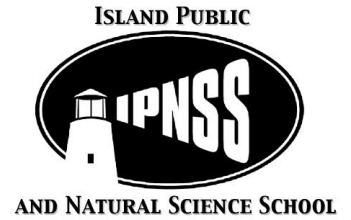

Health Screening Continues

- City-side Students will complete health screening (beginning at 8:25am) at the entrance of the ferry docks
- Island-side students will complete health screening at Centre Island (beginning at 9:00am) prior to joining their class

City-Side Boarding the Ferry after Health Screening

- **Grade 1 to 6** Students may board the ferry to be seated in their designated areas once ferry personnel allow
- **Kindergarten Students** may enter the pre-paid area to check-in with the Travel Safety Assistants; once checked-in they may proceed to board the ferry to be seated in their designated areas once ferry personnel allow

DROP-OFF	September 15 th until Mid-October (no changes in morning routines)
City-Side Families @ the Ferry Docks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will take the 8:45am ferry to Centre Island; Supervised by Travel Safety Assistants • Health Screening of Students prior to entering the fare-paid area and ferry by IPS Staff begins at 8:25am • Grade 1 to 6 Students will walk into school from Centre Island (weather permitting) • Kindergarten students will be transported by school bus in assigned seating
Island-side Families @ Ward's Docks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students can take the 8:45am school bus from Wards Island to Centre Island to meet city-side students • Health Screening of Students takes place at Centre Island by IPS Staff • Grade 1 to 6 Students will walk into school from Centre Island docks (weather permitting) • Kindergarten Students will be transported by school bus in assigned seating

PICK-UP	September 15 th until Mid-October
City-Side Families @ Ferry Docks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will arrive in the city at 3:55pm – pick-up is by 4:10pm • Kindergarten Students will be located within the ferry compound with their designated Travel Safety Assistant • Grade 1 & 2 Students will be located <i>inside</i> the pre-paid ferry compound behind the main entrance ticket booth • Grade 3 to 6 Students will be located <i>outside</i> the main entrance between the Westin Hotel & ticket booth • Please check-in with your Travel Safety Assistant prior to picking up your child
Island-side Families @ Ward's Docks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will arrive at Ward's Island at 3:45pm • Please check-in with your bus driver prior to picking up your child

IPS Family Access Card Continues

Through the agreement of the Toronto Ferry Port Authority, IPS Parents/Guardians will continue to be able to access the Jack Layton Ferry Docks inner compound prepaid area temporarily to safely drop-off and pick-up their child(ren). For IPS Parents/Guardians to continue to access the ferry compound with their child, they must show the **IPS Parent/Guardian Access Card 2021-22** to ferry dock staff.
