- Organize extra-curricular activities.
- Discuss issues between the student and the teacher.
- Ensure lost time to be made up.
- Hold regular conferences involving students, teachers, parents and/or administrative staff.
- Involve School Support Team, support staff and/or outside agencies.
- Determine consequences as deemed necessary by the TDSB Safe Schools Policy.

Do not take things that do not belong to me

Do not vandalize, litter.

Tidy up and put things where they belong.

Stay seated and eat my litterless lunch quietly in the lunchroom.
