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- On the first day of school (September 3rd) staff will be outside directing students where they should line up and there will be clear signage
- The class lists will be posted on the exterior doors at the back of the school
 - JK/SK students Teacher & DECE will greet students at the entrance off Danforth Road at the large fenced in Kindergarten yard
 - Grades 1 & 2 will line up at door # 4
 - ♦ Grades 3/4 & 4/5 will line up at door # 5
 - Grade 6/7 & 7/8 will line up door # 3

Picking up and Dropping Off Students



If you are driving your child to school, please drive with extreme caution. Do not block traffic flow by parking or leaving your vehicle in the driveway off Danforth Road. A staff member will be there from 8:30 am to assist you with dropping off your child. Please utilize Edgely Road, Jaevons Avenue and Rupert Street for dropping off and picking up students, especially grade 4 to 8 students.

Beginning of School Day

Students are welcomed into the schoolyard at 8:30am a.m. each morning. Students are then asked to line up at their assigned classroom entry doors at 8:40 a.m. (a warning bell will sound). Before 8:30 a.m., students will be unsupervised.

Students will enter the school at their designated doors. However, if your child will be late, please enter the building at the front doors (Door 1 - off Birchmount Rd) and report to the office to sign in.

Safe Arrival Call Options for Parents/Guardians - Revised 2024-2025

To help streamline the student absence reporting process, a change has been made to the **Safe Arrival** option in the schools' main telephone menu.

When the Safe Arrival option is selected, the call will be transferred directly to the School Messenger phone system. (Parents/Guardians can still call the **1-833-250-2290** directly and receive the same options). Alternatively, you can download the Safe Arrivals App.

Depending on the phone number they are calling from, callers may hear one of the following messages:

Calling from a phone number registered in PowerSchool

- Parent/Guardian calls main school number and if it's not answered, they get the welcome message
- To report a student absence, press 1 (can be 2 or 3 depending on your specific school) (caller hears *"Wait while I transfer your call"*)
- Then "Welcome to School Messenger notification system for Toronto District School Board"
- For student attendance, press 3
 - For student A in grade..., press 2
 - $\circ~$ For student B in grade..., press 3
 - For student C in grade..., press 4

Calling from a phone number not registered in PowerSchool

- Parent calls main school number and listens to the welcome message
 - To report a student absence, press 1 (can be 2 or 3 depending on your specific school) (caller hears *"Wait while I transfer your call"*)
 - "Welcome to School Messenger notification system for Toronto District School Board"
 - For student attendance, press 3
 - Please enter a phone number that you have registered with a school
 - If the phone number is registered, then parents/guardians will be able to pick the student and report the absence
 - If the phone number is not registered, then they will receive the message "This phone number does not have any children registered to it". Parents/guardians will need to call the school and update data in the Student Information System

End of School Day

Students in JK – Grade 3 will only be released to an authorized individual, and/or as requested by their parent/guardian (e.g., a parent may pick up their child from school or may provide a written note that their child is authorized to leave the school premises with an older sibling).

Individuals authorized to pick up a student by their parents/guardians may be required to show school staff their government issued photo identification.

(Students in Grade 4 - Grade 8 are released upon the final day bell, in the manner authorized by their parent/guardian).

Alternative departure practices may be required for some students in Grades 4 - 8 with Special Education Needs.

Please make every effort to be on time to pick up your child. If an emergency arises, please contact the school immediately at (416) 396-6365
