Dual Credits @ MAC

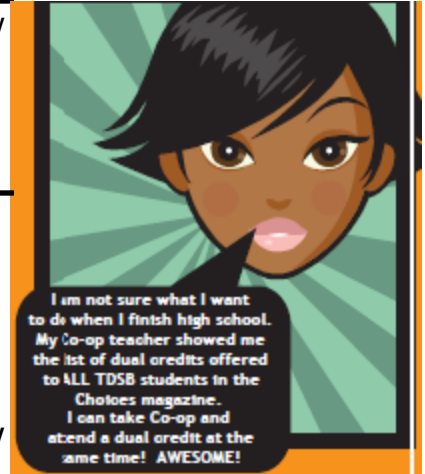
Dual Credit programs provide students with the opportunity to experience learning that appeals to their interests and strengths.

After completing a Dual Credit program, students earn both a college and a secondary school credit!

How do DUAL CREDITS work?

In order to participate in the Dual Credit program:

1. You must be 16 years of age;
2. You must have at least 16 credits;
3. You must have completed the Grade 10 Literacy Test (O.S.S.L.T) or the Ontario Literacy Course;
4. You must be enrolled in 4-credit Co-op.

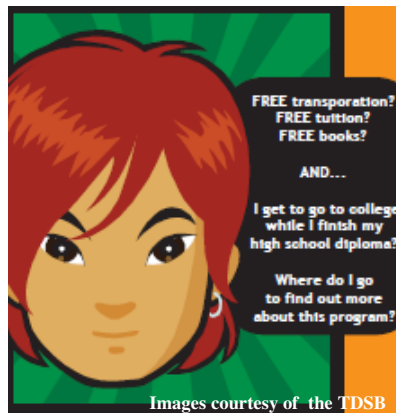
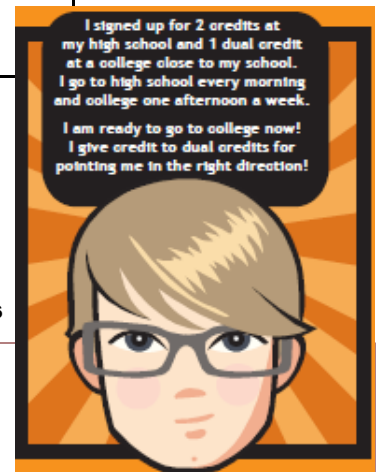
