- 1. **Screening:** All students will need to be screened daily for symptoms of Covid-19.
  - Pre Arrival at home or night before at <u>TDSB Health Screening App</u>.
  - At School Site by a screening table at entry to school.
- 2. **Attendance:** Please call 416-396-6793 to report any student absence.
- Masks: Students will be required to wear non-medical or cloth masks indoors in school, including hallways and during classes. The app provides a direct and simple way to stay connected with your staff and students and will be especially valuable now as students toggle between in-class and at-home learning. The app provides the ability to quickly share announcements, calendar events and more through an easy-to-use interface to help communicate effectively and reduce reliance on email. There is also a School Info section that can replace the district and school created front matter of student agendas.

Students can use it to stay organized with their school work, school day calendar and keep in touch with their school community. Additional features will be added throughout the year to make it even more valuable to students.
