College Admission Requirements

- Ontario Secondary School Diploma (O.S.S.D.)
- English, Grade 12, College Preparation (ENG4C)
- Minimum average of 60%-65%
- Highly competitive programs may have additional requirements

How to Apply?

Students will:

- Create an account with Ontariocolleges.ca
- Pay the \$95 application fee
- Choose up to 5 programs (no more than three at any college)
- Apply by **February 1, 2022** for equal consideration
- Confirm offer by May 1, 2022

University Admission Requirements


- Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD)
- A minimum of SIX Grade "U" or "M" courses ENG4U = English included
- Program-specific prerequisites (typically "U" level)
- Supplementary essays, portfolios, auditions, interviews, etc.

- Pay the \$150 application fee
- Choose up to 3 programs (\$50 for each additional program)
- Apply by **January 13, 2022** for equal consideration
- Confirm offer by **June 1**, **2022**
