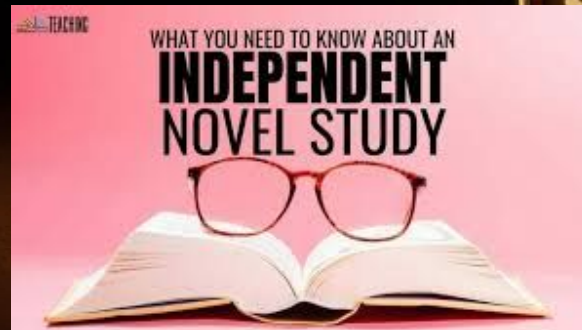
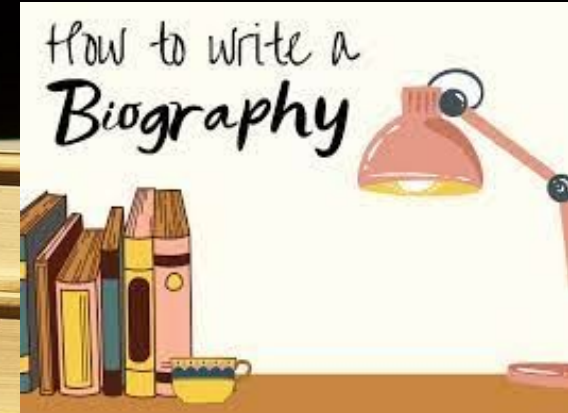


In Grade 11 College English we will....

Course Description

This course emphasizes knowledge and skills related to the craft of writing. Students analyse models of effective writing; use a workshop approach to produce a range of works; identify and use techniques required for specialized forms of writing; and identify effective ways to improve the quality of their writing. They also complete a paper as part of a creative or analytical independent study project and investigate opportunities for publication and for writing careers.
