Attendance:

Failure to provide a Doctor's Certificate to the Vice-Principal will result in a mark of zero for the missed examination. Please avoid scheduling vacations or other events during this time that will result in your child missing exams, which will impact their academic achievement. Please also note that many culminating tasks and review activities take place in the weeks leading up to exams, so absences from school during this time should be avoided. Student Expectations:

- Students must supply their own pens, pencils, rulers, erasers, math sets, calculators, and other materials required for their examination. Students may NOT share materials.
- Students cannot leave the examination room at any time during the examination and must remain in the examination room for the entire hour. An "on-call" teacher will supervise washroom emergencies.
