1. Update – Status and next stages of work – KG Group

4. Bright lights left overnight at the site - M. Cuervo

- J. Chan Lights are required because daylight hours are changing. We are allowed to put lights on our property. The lights on the construction site are not as bright as the street lights. We have to ensure that the site is lit and secure at all times.
- J. Chan will look into seeing what they can do to redirect the lights away from the houses. **Update** KG Group has addressed the issue with the lighting. There are no other complaints re: this item from the community.

5. Asbestos report and other documentation – T. Razek

- S. Shaw we have always preferred to have the reports explained to parents by the right people so they understand the information in the reports. We will post the asbestos and lead report on the John Fisher website but would like to have some Q & A's available to post along with them along with a covering letter to explain what we are doing and why.
