A few reminders:

Dressing Appropriately:

Brrrrr...the weather is getting cold. Please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately. The best way to prepare for both indoor school time and outdoor recess time is to have your child dress in layers. Students also need indoor shoes that stay at school. A warm coat or jacket and snow pants and water proof boots are necessary once the weather is below freezing or if there is snow on the ground. All children need to have hats and mittens or gloves as well. Please label all outdoor clothing.

The Toronto District School Board Cold Weather Policy: When the temperature and/or wind chill factor indicates -28C or lower, children will remain indoors due to risk of frost-nip and frostbite.

Lunches

As part of the TDSBs and our focus on student well-being, we ask that parents send nutritious lunches. Please do not send nuts or nut products in lunches or with snacks since many students have severe, life-threatening allergies to nut products. If you are at home, please consider picking up your child and taking him or her home or out for lunch. Your child would enjoy the treat of spending some time with you during the day. We encourage students to bring reusable containers to support our ECO school initiatives. Thank you for helping us make certain that our children have a healthy, safe and enjoyable lunch time!
