Student Attendance and Safe Arrival

The TDSB recognizes that regular attendance is essential to the safety, academic and well-being of all students. The TDSB acknowledges the legal responsibility of students and their parent(s)/guardian(s) to ensure attendance and punctuality. The TDSB will report, track and monitor student absences and lateness. The TDSB will address problematic and prolonged absences and lateness through timely measures or interventions by the principal, guidance counsellors, classroom teachers, social workers, and other appropriate staff employed at the school or in central departments. Report Cards

On November 13 an 'Elementary Progress Report Card' will be sent home for students in Grade 1-8. Please note that this is different from a 'report' card which students will receive later in the year. The intention of the progress report is to comment upon a student's progress towards achievement of curriculum expectations.

Checkmarks will indicate if a child is progressing very well, well, or with difficulty. Learning skills will be found on the first page of the report card under the subheadings of responsibility, organization, independent work, collaboration, initiative, and self regulation.

The teacher will have an opportunity to make comments about the learning skills for strengths and next steps for improvements. For more information, please refer to the website:


