Fundraising Report (Catherine Jones)

Curriculum Support Plan Report (Kristen Uhre & Sehrish Haider)

- Some classrooms have booked Scientists in the School and some have not. Must relay
 to teachers that they should be using the funds by a certain reasonable date. Typically,
 the deadline has been by April. Tell teachers by April to book.
- If SAC is booking a vendor, do they have to be TDSB vendor? Not necessarily.
- Arts Express Tackling anxiety and stress through mindfulness and movement. TDSB grant not being given. For whole school, every class. Kindergarten classes get book re: empathy, antibullying, interactive. Grade 1-3 get book reading and mindful movement. Also, online workshop for parents. Unlimited so there is the opportunity to share with neighbourhood schools. Virtual or in person?
- Discussion: 98 percent money raised by SAC is directly for the kids in the school. Try to use money raised in the current year. Does not go to the board.
- Equity Committee at school there is SAC money available.

Extra-Curricular Activities Report (Jackie Chan)

- Winter After 4 programs have started. 220 kids registered equaling \$50K registration fees.
- T-ball will happen. Registration in March. Monday to Thursday and every grade gets their own day. Need to get permits.

Staffing & Enrolment Update

Our student enrolment is at 634 with very little movement over the past three months.

Support staff: Our DECE situation has stabilized and we are hopeful that we will not have any additional movement this year. As far as our EA situation is concerned, Ms. Vecchio has been on leave for the past two months and unfortunately we have only had a replacement for her on a few days. As far as lunch supervisors are concerned, we are still very short built have implemented a system using our DECE's which has allowed us to have a few adults in both the lunchroom as well as in the yard in addition to school admin covering.

Facilities Update:

The roof work is still ongoing including connection of the drains above the library and room 109 as well as the installation of the decking. Our temporary fence has been installed. The jersey barriers serve a very critical purpose-stopping soil erosion and runoff. We were hoping to decorate these with student art but have been instructed by facilities/design services not to do so for a number of reasons. The permanent fence will likely be installed in the spring. We still experience caretaking shortages on an ongoing basis.

System/School Update:

Members of our school's Equity Committee have continued to meet with TDSB's Team and together we have developed a roadmap as part of our School Improvement Planning focused on Belonging/Well-Being. The committee has also delivered a number of PD sessions for the whole staff and will continue to do so throughout the course of the year.

Strings/Band/itinerant music have continued and now we have the program delivered to our students on Days 1 &3 for 45 minute segments.

EQAO Results have been shared with all teachers and individual student scores have been given out to all staff before the winter break. Our school performed quite well last year both at the Grade 3 & Grade 3 Level.
