

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY POLICY

1. Students must attend all of their classes on a regular basis and must demonstrate excellent effort and attitude and behaviour.
2. Students must be full-time registered students at LCI with a minimum of 3 courses per semester.
3. Students must be passing the majority of their courses with at least a 60% average as of the last reporting period.
4. Students who do not meet all of these criteria will be interviewed by an administrator to determine if they are allowed to participate.

STUDENT ACTIVITY CARDS AND FEES:

The fee for the 2015-2016 school year is \$50.00. This includes a copy of Lakeshore's yearbook and the right to:

- purchase tickets to school dances;
- participate on athletic teams;
- belong to many organizations and clubs and groups;

- receive a photo I.D. card;
- purchase tickets to the prom;

In addition to the student activity fee there may be occasions where students are required to pay a supplies fee for some courses or a user fee to participate in some extra-curricular activities.
