ACHIEVEMENT - GOAL

At Lambton Kingsway, we will continue to improve student achievement in literacy and numeracy among students who are achieving Level 2 or below by using the established LKS best practices in each and every classroom.

- All students will show measurable improvement in literacy (report card data, EQAO) including all students reading at DRA Level 6 by the end of Kindergarten Year 2 (SK) and all students will be at DRA Level 16+ by the end of Grade 1
- All students will show measurable improvement in numeracy (report card data, EQAO) including foundational skills and knowledge in math by the end of Grade 2
- Using student data to drive programming, we will decrease the number of students not meeting the provincial standard in literacy and numeracy
- As a school, we will continue to improve our knowledge and use of Google Applications for Education

ACHIEVEMENT - What are we going to do? (Act)

Lambton Kingsway Best Practices include:

- All teachers will discuss Learning Goals with our students, co-construct success criteria with students, and provide descriptive feedback with all of our students
- All teachers will incorporate the threads of Inclusive Design including; data and design, student voice, engaging families (communication) and the Third Teacher (environment).
- All teachers will make small group instruction a part of their daily practice (i.e. guided reading, math).
- Technology will be integrated in all of our classrooms to continue preparing our students for the 21st century.
- All of our staff will collaborate and work in grade-level and divisional teams to enhance student learning.

EQUITY - GOAL


