### Remembrance Day:



Six beautiful maple trees stand tall in front of the Lambton Park Community School. The story of these six trees began on November 11, 1919 - the first Remembrance Day following the end of World War 1. As a commemorative gesture for 12 soldiers from the Lambton Park community who lost their lives in the war, six trees - two silver maples and four Norway maples - were planted in front of the school. As a school, we intent on continuing to honour and remember by adding to the school yard. On Monday, November the 11th, our students will add symbolic poppies to the front yard and plant Tulip bulbs, as visual pledge to never forget those who sacrificed for our freedom. At 10:40, classes will come to the gym for a short assembly, the moment of silence and last post. Families are welcome to join us.

### Volunteers:

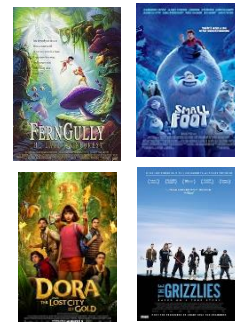


Please ensure students come to school with required winter clothing i.e. appropriate coats/jackets, mitts/gloves, hat, scarf and boots to be outdoors during recesses.

Students are expected to go outside for recesses. Students are kept in-doors for the recesses/morning entry (8:40-8:55 am) for a number of weather conditions such as rain, lightning in the area, extreme winds and extreme cold. When temperature and wind chill measure -28C or lower, students are kept indoors. Outdoor lunch breaks may be shortened if the temperature and wind chill reading is between -20C and -28C. Please ensure that your child(ren) have a pair of indoor shoes at school.

## [French Programs Application](#)

For families interested in the Toronto District School Board's French Immersion or Extended French programs, the board offers an online process for applying to:

- Early French Immersion (EFI) which begins in Senior Kindergarten;
- Junior Extended French (JEF) which begins in Grade 4

The TDSB guarantees an offer of placement in the program (not a specific school) to all on-time applicants. The timelines for applying for these programs for September 2020 are:

- Applications for Early French Immersion (for a Junior Kindergarten aged child), must be completed online between November 4, 2019 and November 29, 2019.
- Applications for Junior Extended French must be completed online between January 6, 2020 and January 31, 2020.

Offers of placement within your chosen program will be made to all on-time applicants in the weeks following the close of the application window.

Please note: families with an older sibling currently in a French program are still required to complete an online application for the new student.
