Stepping Stones is based on Triple P's positive parenting strategies. It helps you manage problem behaviour and developmental issues common in children with a disability. It also helps develop a close relationship with your child, cope with stress, encourage behaviour you like, and teach your child new skills. This 9 week program includes 7 group webinars and 2 one-on-one consultations.
