Some essential steps to help your child develop skills throughout the year and reach his/her full potential are:


- 1. Punctuality and Attendance start a regular routine now so that your child does not miss out on class time. Please arrive on time!






Our teachers will be outside their designated entry doors at **8:30 am** on Tuesday morning. You should receive a welcome email or phone call from your child's teacher before the first day of school. Your child shall meet his/her teacher at the designated entry door in the morning. Students will not be permitted to enter the building through the front door this year. <u>They must enter the school through their designated door.</u>

Every morning teachers will meet their classes at 8:43 am and accompany them to their classroom. **Entry doors are closed at 8:45 am and at that time students will be marked late**. They will have to go around to the front of the building and chick-in at the office.

Please work on developing a morning routine with your children to walk to school if possible and arrive on time. As you are aware, Lescon Road becomes very congested in the morning and after school. Our parking lot is for staff use only. If you need to drive your child to school, you should either drop them off and allow them to walk around independently or park on nearby streets and walk a short distance. **Do not park in our bus loading zone in front of the building. Please never make U-turns on the street in front of the building**. We appreciate your support with keeping our students and your children safe by abiding by all traffic laws on Lescon Rd.
