




Lynnwood Heights celebrated Sikh Heritage Month in April.

The Kindergarten students are learning respect for different cultures as they study Easter, Ramadan and Passover.







Students in grades 1 and 2 are engaged in critical thinking.

Grade 4s' Self-Constructed Pulley Structure










Students in grades 4 and 5 are learning and enjoying dancing for dance class.





Students in grades 2 and 3 Virtual Class went on a virtual maple syrup trip.

Students in grades 4 to 6 created posters about Carnaval De Quebec in French class.







Students in the ISP went for a community outing and are enjoying the nice weather.
