We have been building structures and homes for animals. Kids are learning to communicate their ideas, describe natural occurrences. They are beginning to try new things and choose and use materials to construct things.

“I made a structure with flowers and the cave and the glass.”



“I made a bed for the animals.”

Students are drawing pictures that tell a story. They are starting to write complete sentences for their pictures.



The sentence says, “Elsa is eating at home.” This student has adequate spaces between “words.” They know that “eating” begins with an E and “home” begins with an H.

Our class is using the Sound Wall to help “sound out” new words.
