## \*NEW - Kindergarten Registration Begins in January

Registration for TDSB Kindergarten programs begins in January this school year. We look forward to welcoming our new Junior Kindergarten students in September!

To attend Junior Kindergarten in September, children must turn four years old by December 31, 2025. To register for Senior



Kindergarten, children must be five years old by December 31, 2025. The registration process will be completed online and a meeting will also be booked with the school office staff to complete the registration process.

Kindergarten Registration Begins on Monday, January 6th. Once you complete your registration forms online, the office will review the registration forms and will call you when they are ready to book an appointment with you to complete the registration process.

Our office staff will let you know what documents you will need to have available for your registration appointment and are also able to provide guidance with completing the registration forms online if you have any questions.

Early French Immersion Program/Application Process
The Early French Immersion program begins in Junior
Kindergarten (JK). For September 2025 entry, the
deadline to apply was November 29<sup>th</sup>. Applications
that are submitted after this deadline will be marked
as late and accommodated if space in the program is
available.

In February, only those families who applied by the deadline and have accepted an offer of placement for their child via the <u>central application process</u> can register in Early French Immersion.

# Middle French Immersion (Grade 4 Entry) Application Process

For families interested in the Toronto District School Board's system-wide French Immersion Program, we offer an online process to apply for Middle French Immersion (begins in Grade 4). To apply to the Middle French Immersion Program for September 2025, applications must be completed online between January 6 and 31, 2025. Families with an older sibling currently in a Middle French Immersion program are still required to complete an online application for the new student. #### **Out-Of-Area Admissions Process**

Online applications for both elementary and secondary <u>Out-of-Area Admissions</u> opens on <u>January</u> **6, 2025**. This is the process whereby students can apply to attend a school outside of the school designated to serve their home address. Acceptance is subject to space availability and transportation is the responsibility of the applicant. The <u>Elementary</u> application deadline is <u>January 31 at 4 p.m.</u> and the <u>Secondary</u> application deadline is <u>January 24 at 4 p.m.</u>

# Reminder from the City of Toronto: E-scooters are Illegal and Unsafe (especially for youth under the age of 16)

Electric scooters are not allowed on public roads,

sidewalks or paths in Toronto, regardless of age. In Ontario it is illegal for children under the age of 16



to operate an electric scooter or e-bike.

This past summer, The Hospital for Sick Children saw a notable increase in patients with significant injuries from e-scooter use.

Choose kick-scooters and bicycles that are not battery operated, and ensure children and youth wear a helmet when they ride.
