## **Preparation of Scholarship Application**

- you will be required to fill and print **two hard copies** of your application: one copy that will have your name and one copy that has your name redacted (the anonymous copy will be put forward for consideration to the scholarship committee)
- references—no teacher reference letters will be required for this phase of the application
  - o instead, we ask you to provide the names of the teacher(s) that you have asked for a reference—if you are the chosen applicant, you will ask your teacher(s) for a written reference

## **Submitting your Application**

- please submit your application BEFORE 12pm on the specified day to either Ms. Bhowmik, Ms. Jamal, Ms. McIsaac or Ms.
   Lesser—<u>DO NOT</u> submit your application to any of the secretaries or leave it in anybody's mailbox
- you will receive a receipt saying that your application has been received

## **Scholarship Committee and Timeline**

- the committee is made up of teachers who will review all applications within the first week, and base their decisions on the criteria of the scholarship
- Ms. Duffy will chair the committee and will notify students the status of their application after the first week—chosen candidates will have one week to finalize their application and organize their references
