Important Dates in the Application Process

- **November 1** – The TDSB sends
- your demographic info - name, birthdate, student number
- your grade 11 final marks,
- any final grade 12 marks you have already earned
- list of the courses you are currently enrolled in

to the OUAC (Ontario University Application Centre)

Important Dates in the Application Process

Late Nov. –

The OUAC sends Personal
Identification Numbers and passwords
to schools

Jan. 17 - Deadline for Applications and
Payment

Marks Transmissions

- **November report card marks NOT sent to OUAC**
- **marks are sent by TDSB to OUAC after every other report card - February, April, June**

“Top 6” marks

- All of your grade 11 and 12 marks are sent to universities – you cannot select which marks are sent
- Each faculty in each university determines how to calculate your admission average
- Only marks with a U or M code (University or Mixed college/university preparation) are used in the calculation of your admission average

Additional Requirements

- Some examples: personal statement essays, portfolios, video presentations, auditions
- Pay attention to individual program requirements!
- Pay attention to deadlines!
- Check your email messages and university application log-ins

Private Schools/other School board Credits

- make sure school is licensed to grant credit
- bring official final report card to guidance to enter mark on transcript.
- private schools should enter midterm mark in OUAC
