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3 **Principal's Report**

- The curriculum night was a success and we could see how happy parents were to come to school after so long.
- This year we had 50 new families and ESL and Settlement workers did exceptional job to help the newcomers settle.
- Selling t-shirts and hoodies with new logo turned out to be a great success.
 Students grade 4 and 5 asked for bigger size hoodies and some parents asked for adult sizes for themselves. Ms. Weinberg has already spoken to suppliers to order. The items are still available in the office for purchase if students bring cash.
- Pizza Lunch: Pizza lunches are going well. Thanks to Atefeh and Dallah for buying juice boxes and bringing them to school for our pizza lunches.
- Cross Country: Just about 70 students participated in the qualifying meet at Earl Bales on October 4th, 6 students advanced to the Conference Finals today at Earl Bales, and one student, Leon in grade 4, advanced to the City Championships at Centennial Park on the 26th.
- Boys Soccer Team: Had their tournament at Denlow. They tied one game and lost 2 so they did not advance but they had a fantastic time.
- Clubs: some popular clubs are starting soon, including yoga in music room, running club and French club.
- Forms to register for different clubs are going home soon. But keep in mind spaces are limited. If there's a lot of interest, it may be divided up into fourweek intervals to rotate among interested students.
- Fundraising plan is required by the principal to be submitted to the superintendent at the end of October. At McKee, SAC carries out most of

- Food Drive Maria is going to send the information about the dates, etc. to
 Ms. Lang. Then information will be shared with students and parents. Food
 drive is not only about sharing food, but learning and having dialog that
 connects kids with real life.
- Universal Screening: CCAT for all Grade 3 students will be held on October 25, 26 and 27. The data from this screening are supposed to show teachers how children are learning and how teachers can use different strategies in response to that.
- Halloween: Teacher leads will meet with their team to come up with a plan for how to have some fun on Halloween.
- Reorganization: This was the most difficult part of Ms. Lang's job. 4.5
 teachers were added to our team, for which they are grateful because they
 could interview and choose among the line up of teachers requesting to
 join McKee.
- Optional Attendance: If your child is in Grade 5 and wanting to attend a different school than is assigned, the deadline to submit the form is February 23rd, 2023. Ms. Lang can answer any questions.
