Hints for Examination Preparation:

- Attend every class.
- Plan your study time.
- Know exactly what is being covered on the examination.
- Find a good place to study.
- Keep your notes up to date.
- Review your textbooks at appropriate points.
- Listen attentively to your teachers and peers.
- Divide your studying into realistic sections with breaks.
- Follow directions.
- Study well in advance so that all areas will be reviewed.
- Take part in class review activities.
- Ask questions when you are not sure of something
- Review all class notes and hand-outs.
- Highlight the key points.
- Get all those end of term assignments in for that important term mark.

Attendance:

Remember the time and location of each of your examinations. Highlight the examinations you are to write, then fill in your personal timetable noting the subject, date and time of exam and the location. It is the student's responsibility to be at the correct place at the correct time for each of their examinations. If in doubt ask your subject teacher for the location and date of your examination. Each day's schedule will be posted in the front hall.

Lateness:

Students who are late for examinations should go directly to their exam room. **No extra time will be given to a student arriving late for an examination.**

Missed Examinations:

Students who miss examinations due to illness **MUST** bring a Doctor's Certificate dated the day of the missed exam to the Vice-Principal. Failure to provide a Doctor's Certificate to the Vice-Principal will result in a mark of zero for the missed examination. No make-up examinations will be permitted. Please avoid scheduling vacations or other events during this time that will result in your child missing exams, as this will have an impact on their academic achievement. Please also note that there are many culminating tasks and review activities that take place in the weeks leading up to exams and so absences from school during this time should be avoided

Library:

Library is open for quiet individual study. Students not respecting this quiet rule will be asked to leave. The library will be open from 8:30 to 10:15 every day.

Student Expectations:

- ▶ Students must supply their own pens, pencils, rulers, erasers, math sets, calculator and other materials required for their examination. Students may NOT share materials.
- ▶ Students cannot leave the examination room at any time during the examination and must remain in the examination room for one full hour. Washroom emergencies will be supervised by an "on call" teacher.
- ▶ Students must not linger in the halls or corridors after their examinations, as other students may still be completing their examinations.
- ▶ Students are **NOT ADMITTED** to their exams who have their cell phone or any electronic devices or students who are wearing or carrying coats, hats, backpacks. They should be put in their locker.

NO food or drinks will be permitted in the exam room.

Academic Honesty:

Students will not have access to any unauthorized materials which might be of assistance to them in writing the examination. Students who are caught cheating will be given a mark of **ZERO** for the examination and may be subject to other disciplinary action by the Vice-Principal.
