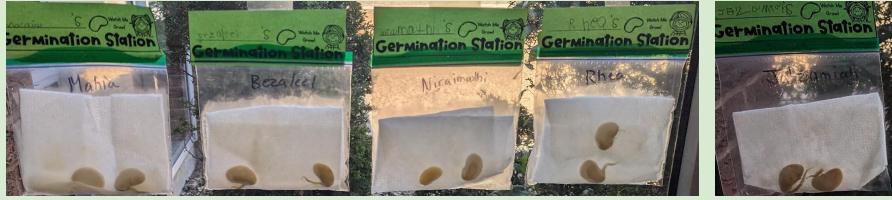

Germination Station



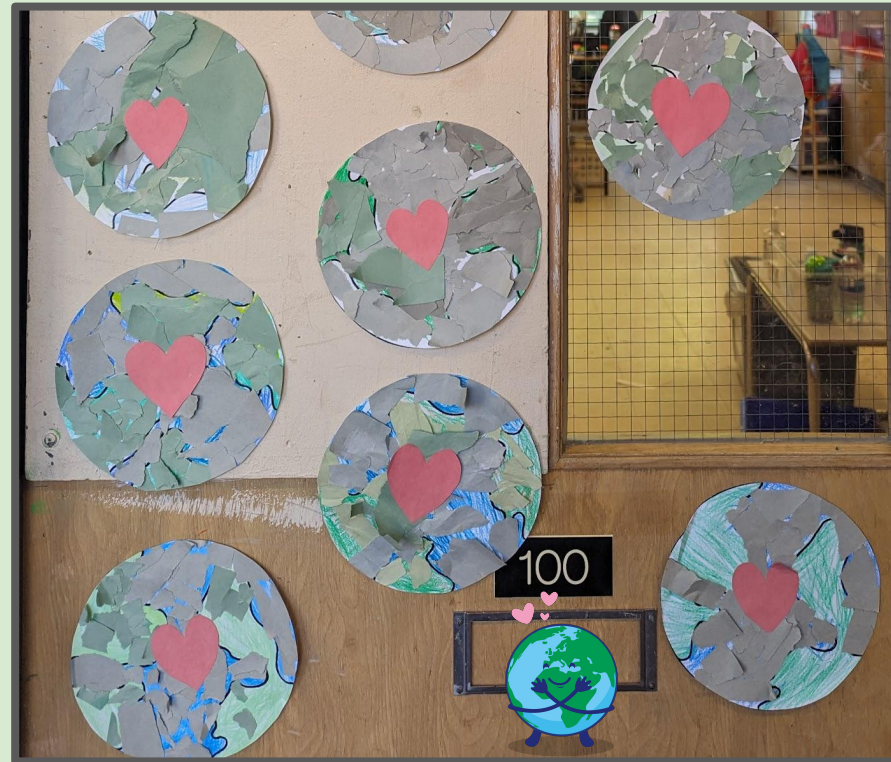
