

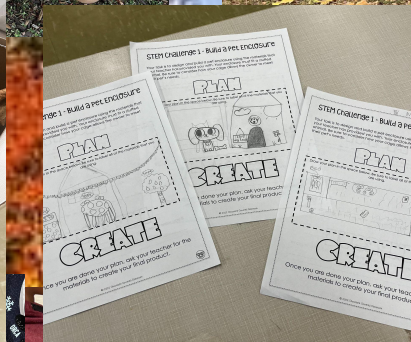
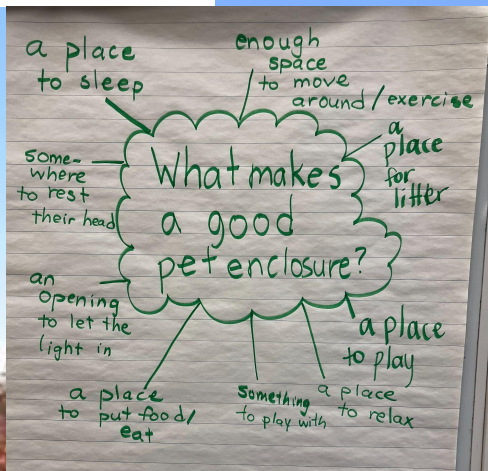
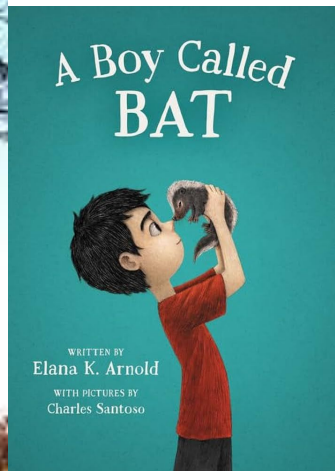
Grade 3/4:

Students brainstormed ideas, drafted their tales, and edited them into eerie adventures.

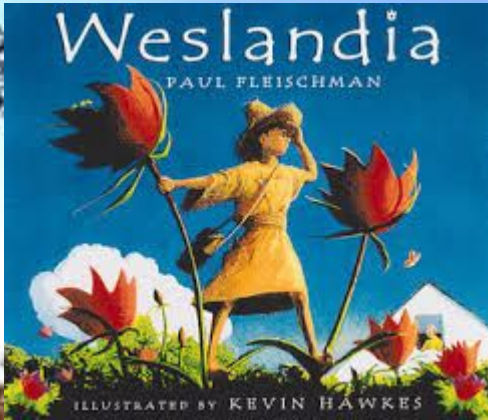


Grade 4/5A
