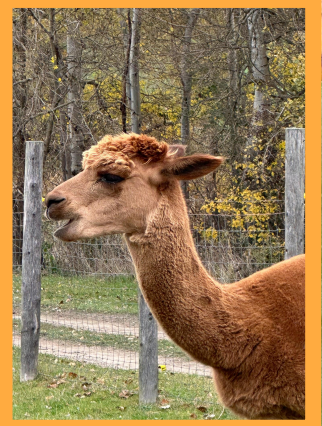


Grade 1/2 A and B

Grade 1/2 A and B

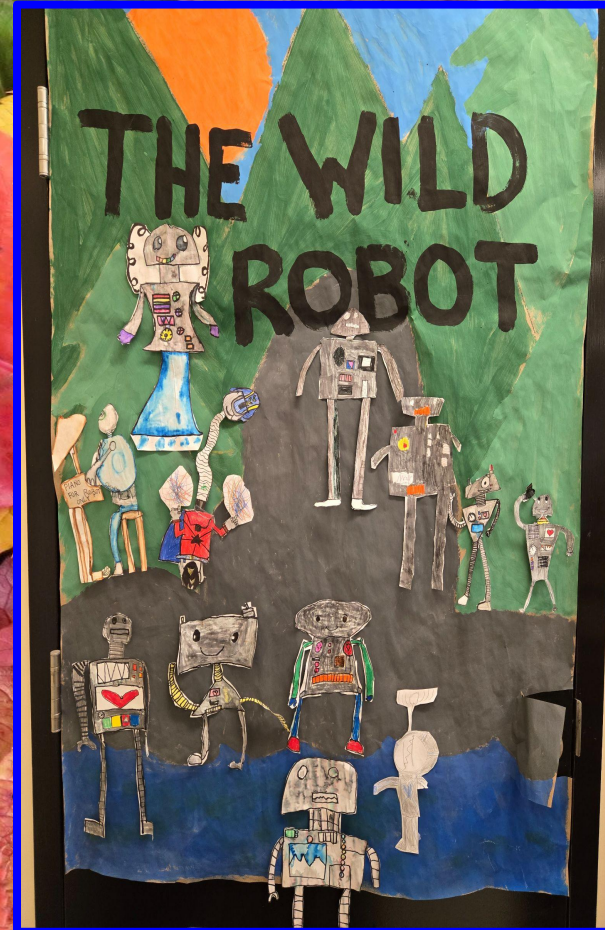


Grade 1/2A and B have been learning a lot together this year. We also entered the pumpkin carving contest together and were crowned the **WINNERS!**

Grade 2/3A

Grade 2/3 B

Grade 2/3 B thoroughly enjoyed the diverse celebrations of Halloween and Diwali in the month of October! We enjoyed decorating and painting our class pumpkin that turned into a spooky witch. Diya and rangoli art made the colourful festival of lights come to life in our classroom!



Grade 3/4: In our Rocks and Minerals Science Unit, we learned about mining—its benefits and its impact on the environment. To see this in action, we “mined” chocolate chips from cookies! We tried to keep the crumbs within a grid on paper, but saw how hard it was to keep the “mining area” clean. This showed us how mining can affect the environment and wildlife, helping us see that while we gain important resources, it also has an impact on the natural world.



Grade 4/5A

This month 4/5A worked on the design element of line and made Zentangle Pumpkins for one of their art projects. The students each drew their own pumpkin, then drew Zentangles in the spaces, and finished by colouring. They drew contour lines of the pumpkin, lines of various weights, and repetition of lines to create visual rhythm.

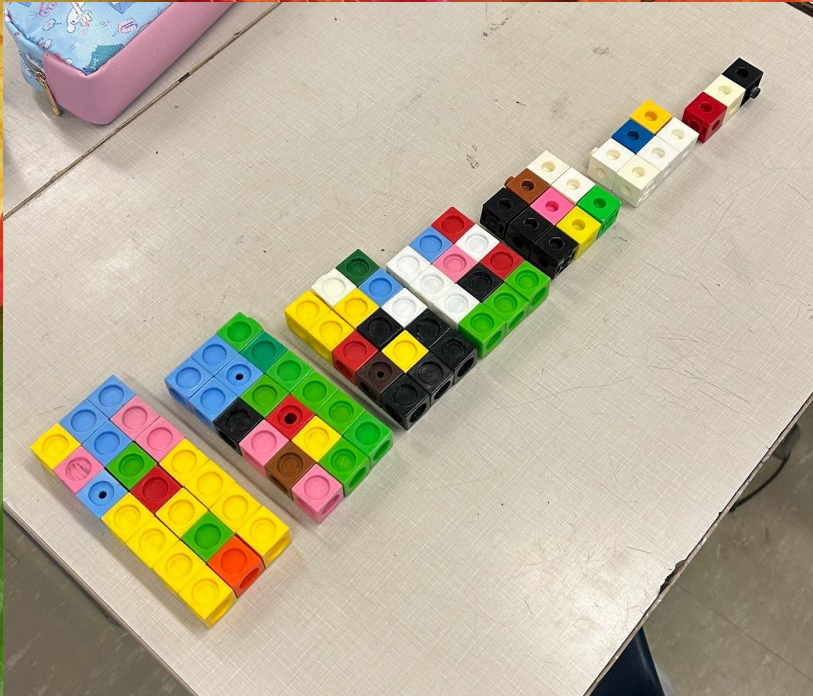
Zentangle is an art form of drawing simple, repeated patterns to create beautiful pictures. Like focused doodling, it emphasizes enjoying the creative process over the final result. This relaxing activity promotes focus, mindfulness, and creativity.

ZENTANGLE PUMPKINS

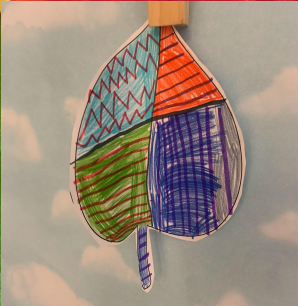


Grade 4/5 B

Halloween Pumpkin Carving Contest and Dance!

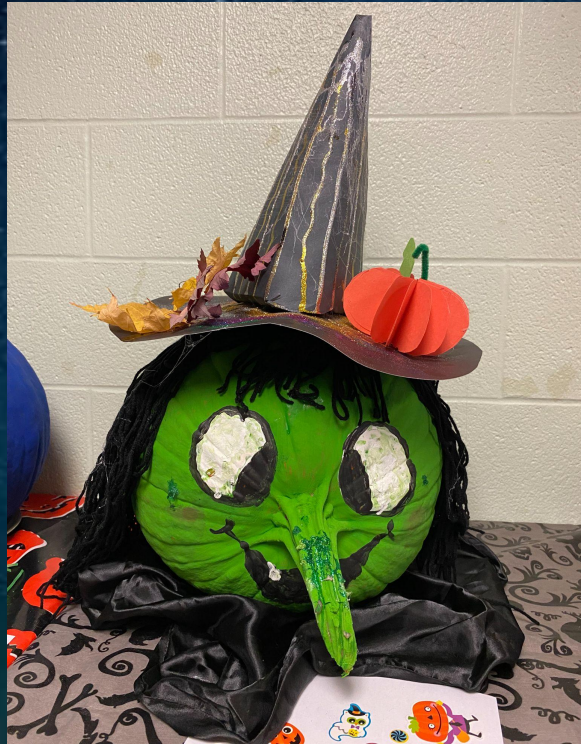
This month, the students and teachers at Muirhead participated in a pumpkin carving contest to celebrate Halloween. The results speak for themselves....

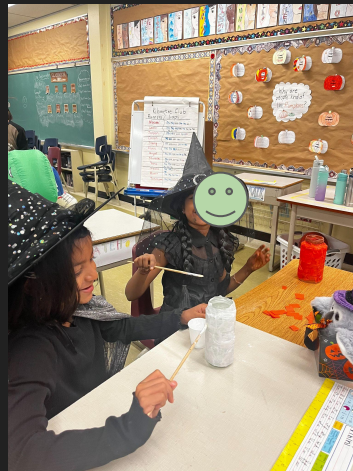
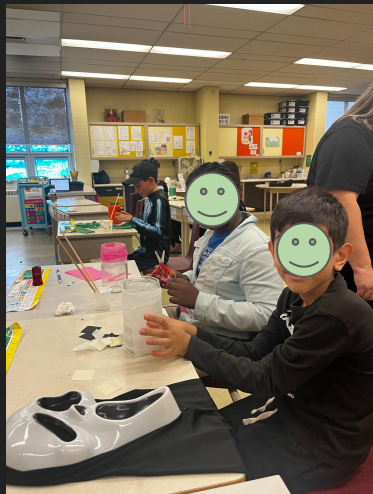

Art Club - October

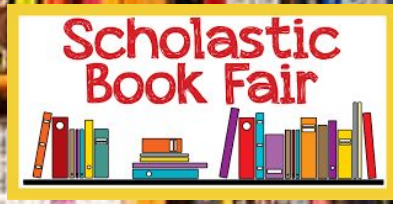


This month the Art Club made some Halloween-inspired lanterns! It was spook-tastic!

Most of our schools have new Superintendents this year. This is an opportunity for Ward 13 parents and caregivers to meet them and share ideas to support students in Ward 13 schools.

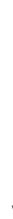
