## Morning Bins in Rm 140 - Ms. Yerakarakos

Rm 140 begins the day with Morning Bins to help get focused and start the learning day with a "minds-on" perspective!

We have a rotation of 5 bins containing various materials used in a week. Each contains a task card with steps students read and follow for completion. Tasks can be math, language or stem based. Students write and draw about their completed task using a "Morning Bin Task sheet". A labelled diagram with a sentence to describe their finished product is the modelled expectation.
